Scripture and Prayer

Do you ever plan backwards? You picture in your mind what you want your post-remodel kitchen to look like. And then start planning backwards, listing all that needs to be done in order for the picture to become reality.

Revelation 7 paints an awesome picture:

After this I saw a vast crowd, too great to count, from every nation and tribe and people and language, standing in front of the throne and before the Lamb. They were clothed in white and held palm branches in their hands. And they were shouting with a mighty shout, "Salvation comes from our God on the throne and from the Lamb!" (verse 9, NLT)

Let's picture more of what this looks like so we can plan backwards.

Isaiah 56 tells us that, "the foreigners who joined themselves to the Lord, to minister to him, to love the name of the Lord, and to be his servants... these I will bring to my holy mountain and make them joyful in my house of prayer." (verses 6-7, ESV)

And Psalm 145 fills in more of the picture. "All your works shall give thanks to you, O Lord, and all your saints shall bless you! They shall speak of the glory of your kingdom and tell of your power, to make known to the children of man your mighty deeds, and the glorious splendor of your kingdom." (verses 10-12, ESV)

How are those from every nation and tribe and people and language going to hear? One generation shall commend God's works to another, and shall declare his mighty acts. (from Ps 145:4)

We are called to make God known to the nations, who speak other languages. And that's where Bible translation comes in. The Bible that's "translated" through each of our lives as we live out the truth of the gospel, as we walk with the Lord of the universe in our homes and work and neighborhoods. The Bible that's translated into more and more of the world's more than 7,000 languages.

We long for the world to know Jesus, to love him, to worship him. Today, God is bringing many peoples of the world to our doorsteps! When you meet someone whose first language is not English, ask them what language they prefer to speak. Together you can explore Find.Bible or ScriptureEarth.org to see if they can find resources there.

What if your new friend finds there are no resources in their language, that theirs is one of the nearly 2,000 languages still waiting for translation to begin? Then you know how to pray. Pray for God to move in the hearts and lives of believers who will be instrumental in translating scripture into this language. Pray for those who will be trained as translators and who will go. Pray for those who will be part of the team supporting the translators through technical and logistical support. Pray for those providing finances for all this to move forward.

Pray that as you interact with your friend, God will use your words and your life to bring the message of hope beyond understanding, the message of God's love and mercy and grace. Pray that one day your friend will be among those standing in front of the throne and before the Lamb.
