The Names of God

This side of Heaven, it is impossible for our finite human minds to fully comprehend God's infinite, holy, awe-inspiring nature. We can only know what God chooses to reveal about Himself. In Scripture He reveals Himself to us through His attributes and through His names. We considered God's attributes earlier this year, so now we begin a series on the names of God.

Lord God The Ancient of Days

What do you think about when you hear this name for God – "Ancient of Days"? That God is really old? God is not old, God is not bound by time or change. We change, we grow old, He doesn't. He reveals Himself as the Ancient of Days to help us time-bound creatures grasp something of the vastness of His eternal nature. This title declares God's unchangeableness and inexhaustibleness. The generations and kingdoms of man come and go, but God is the everlasting God, the God of eternity. God has the long view, He measures time in millennia.

Meditate on the title of the Ancient of Days. One of the things we associate with ancient is ancient wisdom, ancient truth. What would it be like to sit at the feet of the God of ancient wisdom, who knows the end from the beginning and all things in between? Why don't we take the time to do that more? Reflect on Isaiah 46:9-10 below.

Reflections from Scripture on the Lord God as Ancient of Days

Genesis 21:33 Abraham planted a tamarisk tree in Beersheba and called there on the name of the Lord, the Everlasting God.

Psalm 90:1-2 Lord, you have been our dwelling place in all generations.

Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Isaiah 44:6-7 Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the Lord of hosts:

"I am the first and I am the last; besides me there is no god.

Who is like me? Let him proclaim it. Let him declare and set it before me,

since I appointed an ancient people. Let them declare what is to come, and what will happen."

Isaiah 46:9-10 Remember the former things of old;

for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,'

Daniel 7:9 As I looked, thrones were placed, and the Ancient of Days took his seat; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames; its wheels were burning fire.

Daniel 7:13-14 I saw in the night visions,

and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him.

And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

Micah 5:2 But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.
