April 17: Northwest Seafarers Ministry

In 2020, Seafarers Ministry included volunteers visiting ships at Cherry Point, WA and in Florida under the same ministry umbrella, serving seaman from many countries who travel all over the world on ships. That summer, those visiting ships at Ferndale, WA saw the need to separate the two ministries. The team visiting ships at Cherry Point became **Northwest Seafarers** and the ministry in Florida, **Seafarers Mission**. Some ships arriving locally carry crude from various countries to the refineries at Cherry Point. Others, load finished products from these refineries and transport them to other nations. When the local Seafarers visit crew members aboard ships, they listen to them talk about family back home and their work on the ship. They, with open arms, receive us and we are blest to distribute Gideon Bibles, New Testaments and APP cards. The APP cards allow the crew to download the APP onto their phone enabling them to receive the Bible in their native tongue! We are encouraged when we ask if we can pray with them and how responsive they are to this request.
