SEEKING REFERENDUM 101 SIGNATURES

During the spring of 2023, Washington state legislative session, a highly partisan bill, ESSB 5599, was passed regarding homeless or runaway youth seeking what's referred to as "protected health care services." These services provide gender-related medical intervention, such as puberty blockers, sex change surgeries, and mastectomies, as well as abortions. In the bill, certain shelters and organizations are exempt from the requirement to contact the parents when the child enters the shelter.

Referendum 101 seeks to overturn this bad law. By signing the petition for Referendum 101 by July 15, citizens will have the opportunity to Reject SB 5599 on the November ballot. Find more information at <u>www.reject5599.com</u>. You can sign the petition by contacting Glen B.
